<p>For all reported cases of sexual assault under Texas Code of Criminal Procedure Article 56.06, a <b>law enforcement agency (LEA) must:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use this form to document the decision whether to request a sexual assault exam</li> <li>• Provide a copy of this completed form to:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <b>both</b> the health care facility <b>and</b> the sexual assault examiner or sexual assault nurse examiner who provides services to the victim that are related to the sexual assault; and</li> <li>○ the victim or the person who consented to the sexual assault exam on behalf of the victim</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Maintain the completed form in accordance with the LEA's record retention policies</li> </ul> <p>The Office of the Attorney General <b>will not</b> process an application for reimbursement of the forensic costs of the sexual assault exam under Article 56.06 without a copy of this completed form.</p>
